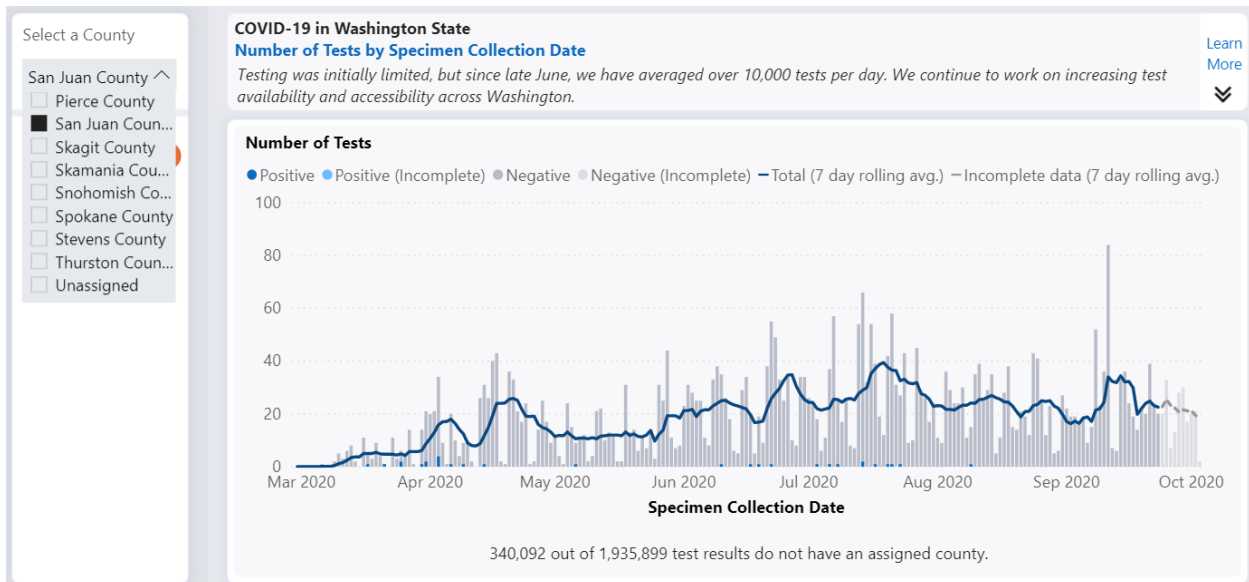
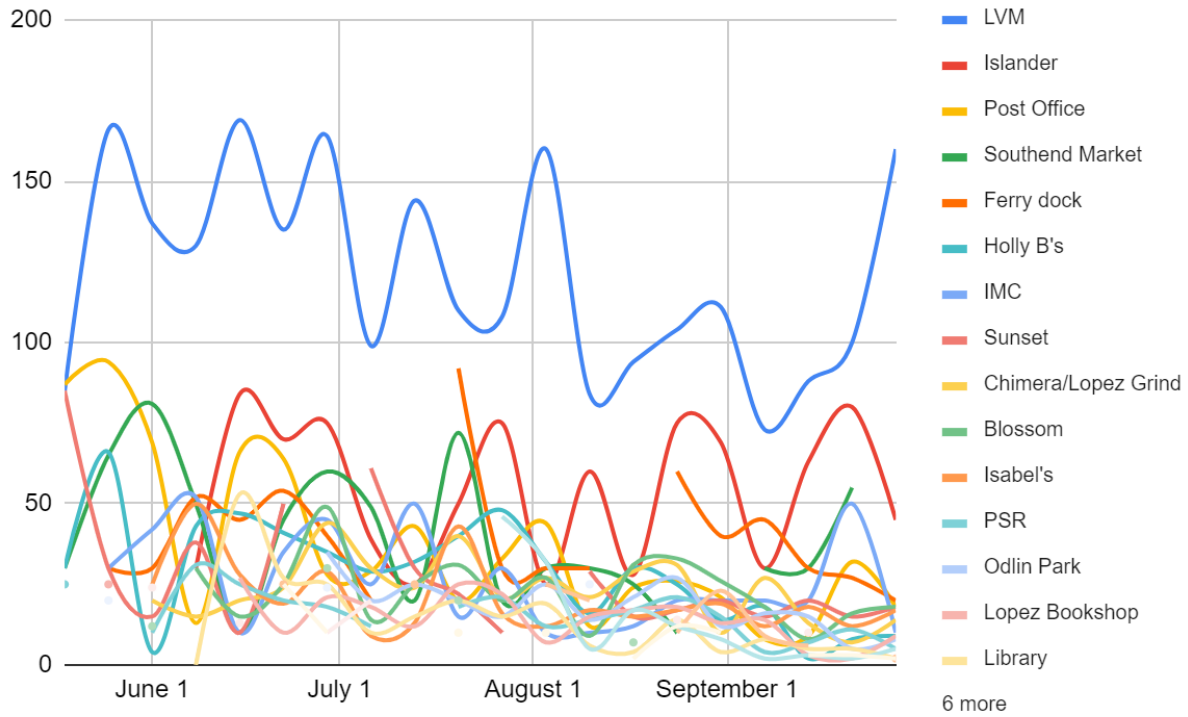


With over 100,000 Americans infected since the first public news of POTUS testing positive for COVID-19, it is a clear reminder that the pandemic is very much with us and will be for a while. For SJ county, we seem to hover around 20-30 tests a day (graph below) but our last positive case was in August. Our number of cases has held steady at 32 for the past two months. This is amazing considering the number of tourists and visitors who came to our islands this summer. We are grateful for our community's collective decision to take personal responsibility, to be respectful and worthy of the sacrifices of our frontline healthcare professionals and volunteers, and to care for the wellbeing of our community members.



To date, we have distributed 10,400 masks . Our hope was/is that things would slow down and so would the demand for the masks. Looking at the graph of weekly mask distributions, we do see a general declining trend since June/July. But we also notice a recent uptick in demand at LVM (top blue line) and a pretty steady high demand at Islander (top red line).
